Presidents Message

What a start to the season! So many great things that has happened!

Firstly, it is really pleasing to see the performances of our Bullets to date. With *many PBs, Club Records and exceptional performances*, I feel our Bullets are looking good in good shape for the rest of the season.

Secondly, the *club has now 31 registered athletes* which is the *second best since the 1998-99 season*. This is despite a few athletes moving on for different reasons and we were still able to maintain a high retention rate. Thanks to those for inviting their friends to have their children have a go at athletics.

Thirdly, in September the BBLAC spent a whole day at the Bayswater South Primary School delivering a "*Little Athletics in School program*" to over *100 students from prep to Grade 6*. This was supported by Victorian Little Athletics Association and KLAC. Everyone had a ball and the BBLAC added a new initiative by showing off an impressive Photo Video presentation of our Bullets in action. The school and everyone involved enjoyed the occasion and we look forward to doing same at other schools. If you think you can help please let us know.

Did you know that on the 3rd of November this year *it was exactly 38 years to the day when BBLAC competed for the first time* and became a founding member of KLAC? If you haven't seen the latest on our website I would strongly encourage you to do so. There are some fascinating information about the history of the club plus memorabilia items and photos that you have to see.

In two years time we will be celebrating our 40th year milestone and hence we are very excited to announce that Bayswater MP Peter Lockwood's Office called us to say our Local History Grants Program application worth \$2,524 for the "*Bayswater Bullets Little Athletics Club 40th Anniversary History Project*" was accepted.

This Program in conjunction with the Knox Historical Society will work to have our missing information from the mid 1970's to the late 1980's researched. It is also to produce a "Digital Story" DVD of our club history. This grant would not have happened without enthusiastic support of the BBLAC committee but more so the dedicated perseverance of Stephen Egan who along with Steve Flemming worked long hours to put the application together. Steve Flemming's father is a Life Member of Fairpark Flyers Little Athletics Club and his sister is Heptathlon Commonwealth Gold medalist / athlete Jane Flemming!

Week 2 - 14th Oct 2006

Best PB effort for the day was by U/15 **Josh Holdway** who had 5 PB's with U/10 **Jorgia Foster** and U/11 **David Thomson** obtaining 4 PB's. Excellent effort!

Week 3 - 15th Oct 2006

Best PB effort for the night was by U/10 **Jessica Richardson** who had 4 PB's. Next best was by U/8 **Cody Norton** and U/11 **David Thomson**, both with 3 PB's.

With the introduction of a Seasons Best (SB), our first athlete to obtain this was by U/14 **Daragh Moore** with 2 SB's for the night.

Week 4 - 28th Oct 2006

Congratulations to U/8 **Alexander Barton-Smith** and U/15 **Josh Holdway** who have both broken Club Records today. Alexander broke a 21 year old U/8 100m record with a time of 16.47 sec, the old record of 16.60 sec was set on 19th Oct 1985. Josh broke the U/15 110m Hurdles record with a time of 22.10 sec. The previous record was 22.82 set on 22 Feb 2003.

Best PB effort for the day was by U/8 **Alexander Barton-Smith**, U/8 **Nathan Goodger**, U/9 **Erin Holdway** and U/15 **Josh Holdway** all with 4 PB's.

Well done to U/11 **David Thomson**, U/9 **Erin Holdway** and her brother U/15 **Josh Holdway**, all have reached their 10 PB Certificate status.

Week 5 - 4th Nov 2006

Best PB effort for the morning was by U/11 **David Thomson** with 5 PB's followed by U/7 **Adam Maggs**, U/11 **Aiden Hartney** and U/15 **Josh Holdway** all with 4 PB's.

Congratulations to U/10 **Emma Thomson** has reached her 10 PB Certificate and U/11 **David Thomson** and U/15 **Josh Holdway** have reached their Bronze PB Medal status.

Week 6 - 11th Nov 2006

U/15 **Josh Holdway** broke his own 110m Hurdles Club Record as well as a new U/15 Javelin Record with a throw of 28.79m, the previous was 24.40m set on 28 Feb 1997. U/11 **David Thomson** ran the 200m Hurdles in a Club Record time of 35.90 sec - the previous record 38.77 sec was set on 23rd Mar 2002.

Best PB effort was by U/15 **Josh Holdway** with 5 PB's. U/8 **Cody Norton**, U/10 **Emma Thomson** and U/11 **David Thomson** all obtained 4 PB's for the morning.

Also well done to U/8 **Zack Welsh** obtaining his first PB's for the season with a total of 3 PB's.

U/14 **Daragh Moore** is the first to obtain a PB bonus point upon attaining her third SB (Season's Best) today.

Congratulations to U/8 **Cody Norton**, U/8 **Nathan Goodger**, U/8 **Jack Bole-Brown** and U/10 **Jorgia Foster** who have all reached their 10 PB Certificate as well as to U/15 **Josh Holdway** who is the first to reach his silver PB Medal status.
